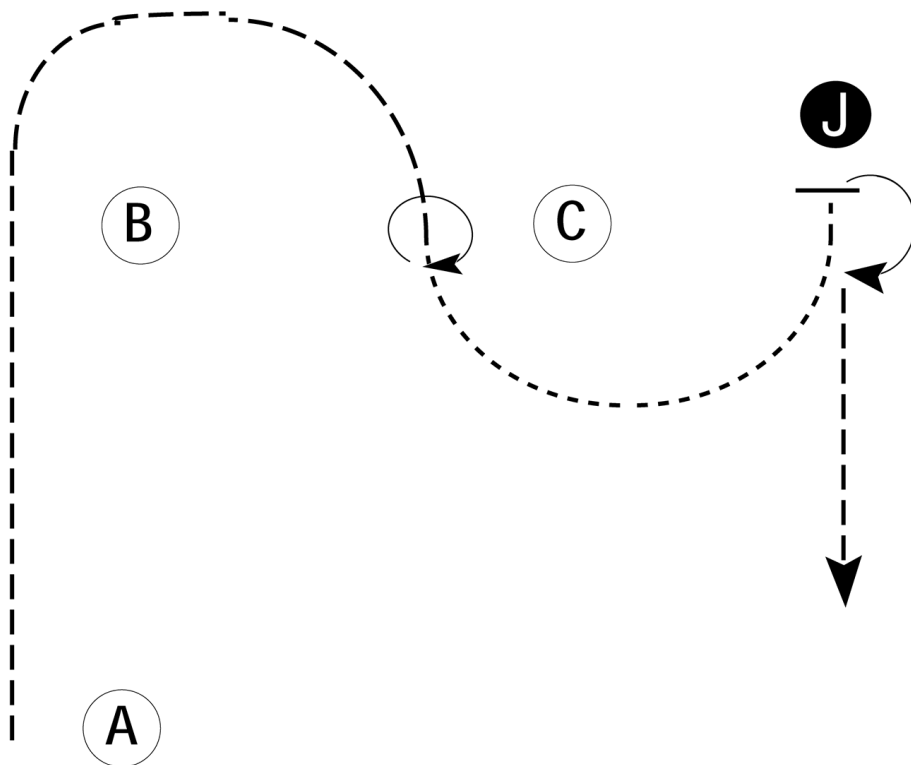

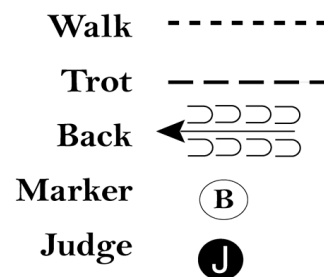
## English Showmanship (Classes 29-35)

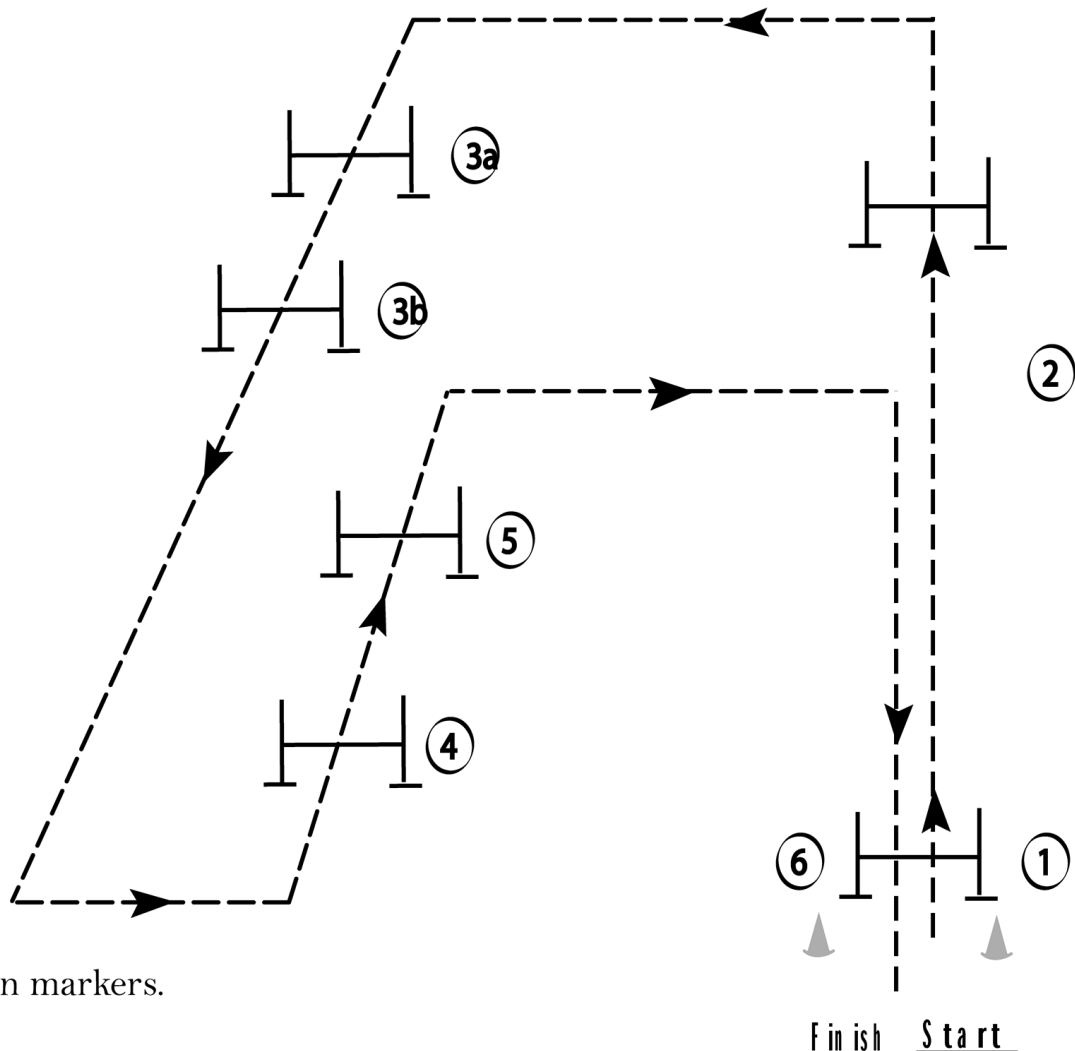

## Hunter & Jumper in Hand (Classes 37- 55)

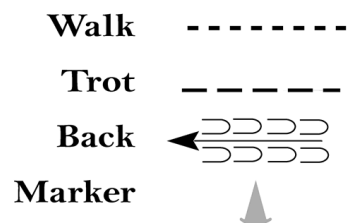
Show Date: 07-12-2025

3. Continue over in and out jumps.
4. Continue over brick wall jump.
5. Continue flower box jump.
6. Repeat schooling standard jump.

Exit between markers.

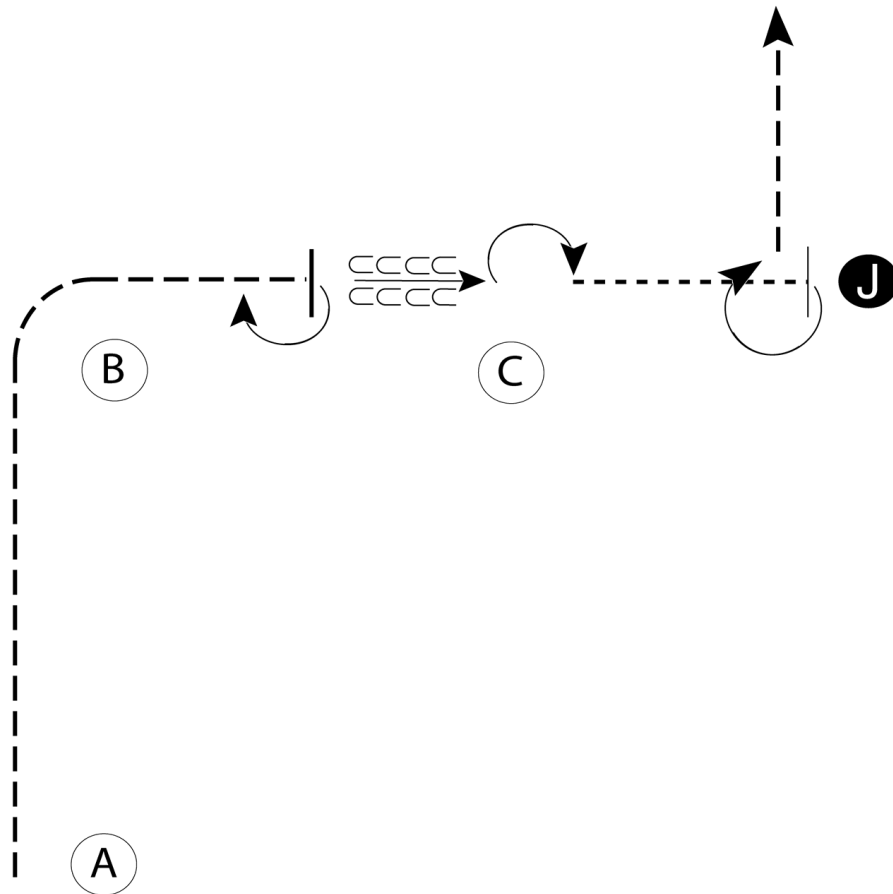

## Western Showmanship (Classes 87 - 93)

Show Date: 07-12-2025



1. Jog from A around B
2. Half way to C stop and perform a 180 degree turn
3. Back to C
4. Perform a 180 degree turn, walk to Judge and set up for inspection
5. When dismissed perform a 270 degree turn and trot to lineup

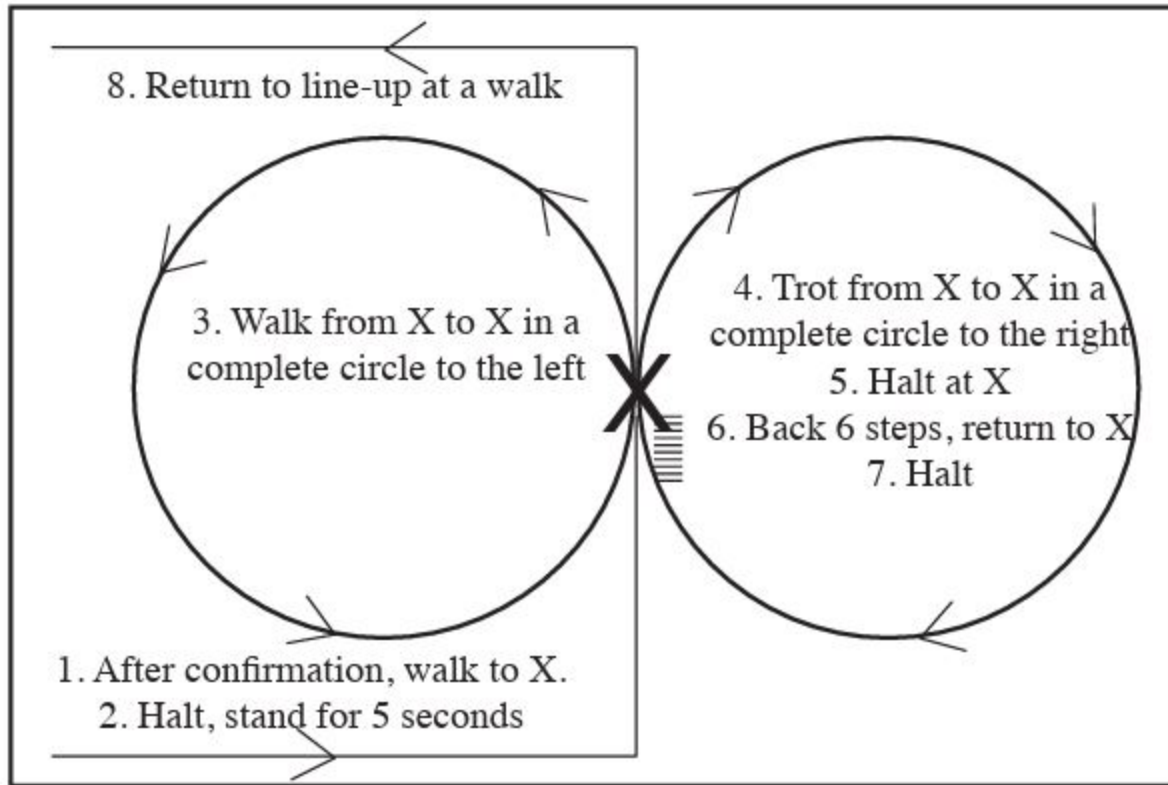

Diagram illustrating a quantum circuit for a 2-qubit system. The circuit starts with two qubits, J and A, both in state  $|0\rangle$ . Qubit J is controlled by qubit A. 1. When acknowledged, back approximately 2 horse lengths.
2. Perform a 450 degree turn ( $1\frac{1}{4}$ ).
3. Trot a half circle back to A.
4. Stop and perform a 180 degree turn.
5. Trot until your horse's hip is even with Judge.
6. Stop and perform a 270 degree turn.
7. Walk to judge. Stop and set up for inspection.
8. When dismissed, perform a 90 degree turn.
9. Walk straight away from judge.

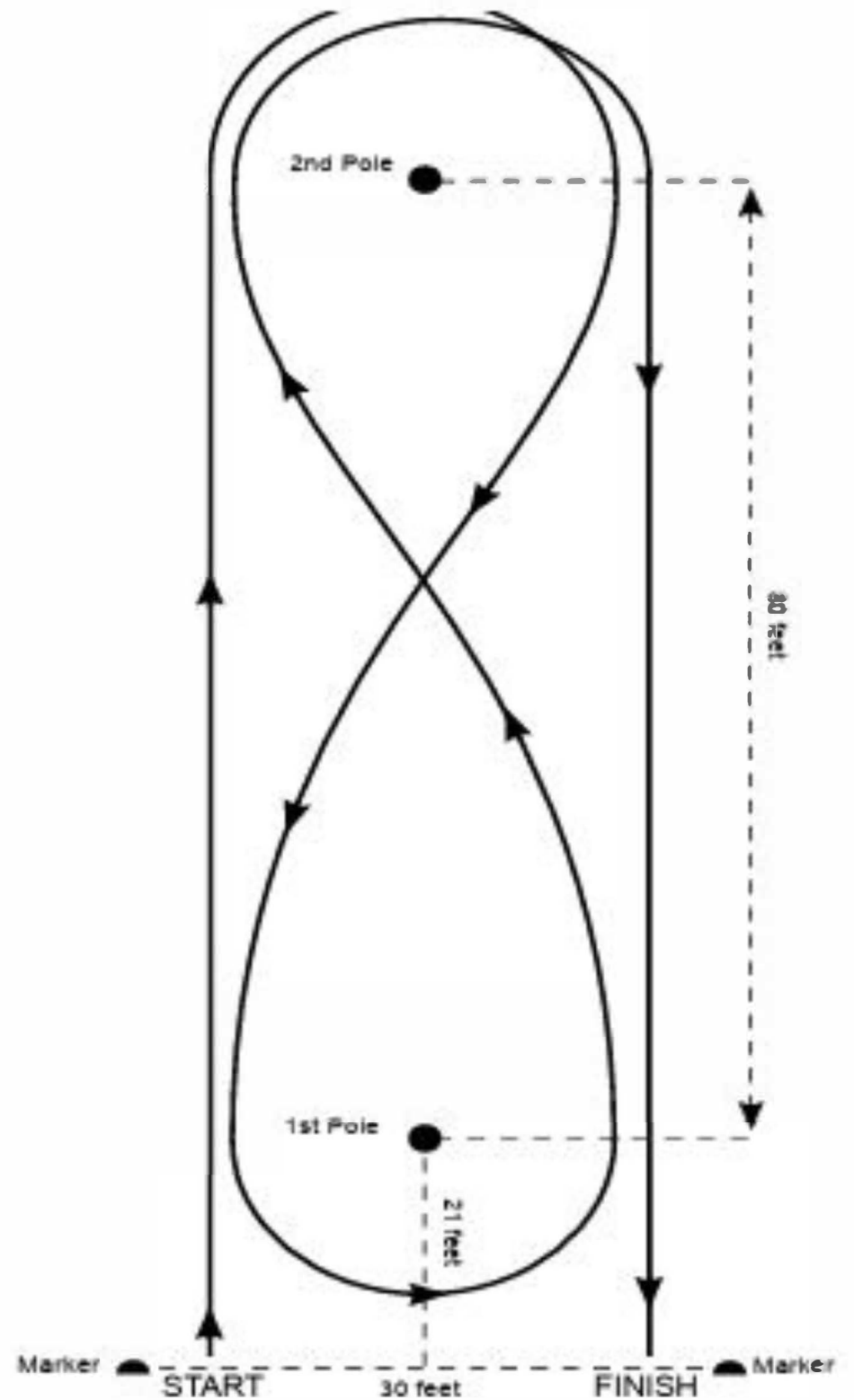
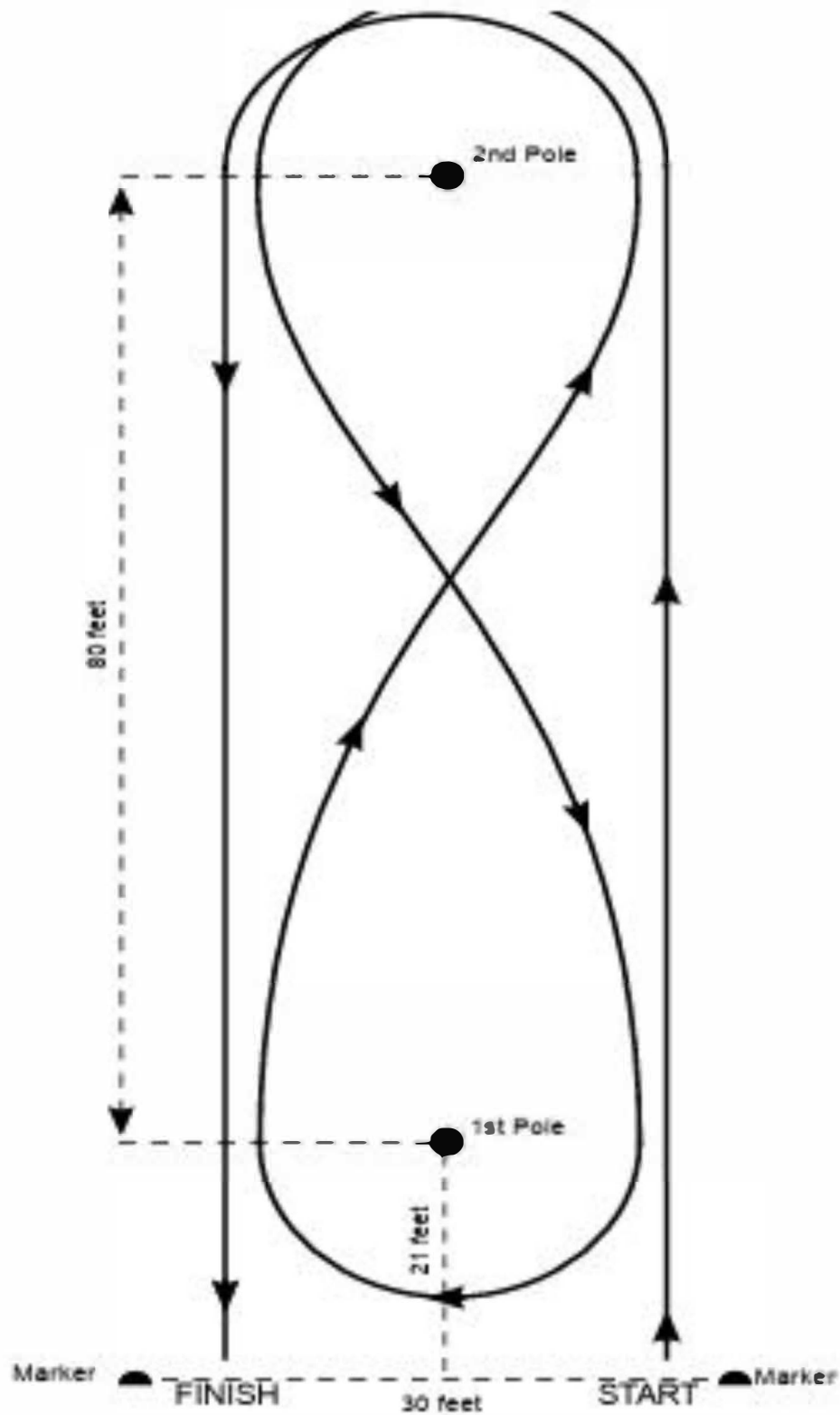

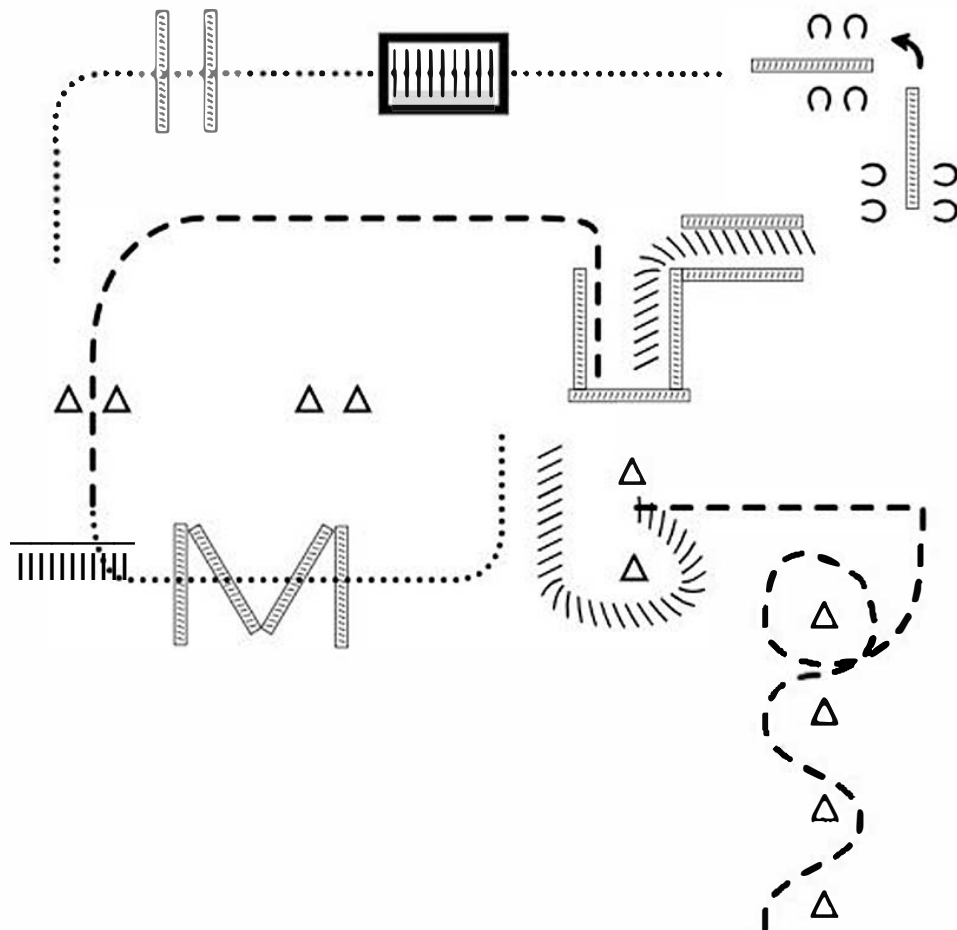

5. Back L
6. Sidepass first pole
7. 90° turn and sidepass second pole
8. Walk over bridge and poles
9. Exit at a walk

(LONG LINE ONLY - not to cross enter driving Obstacle)

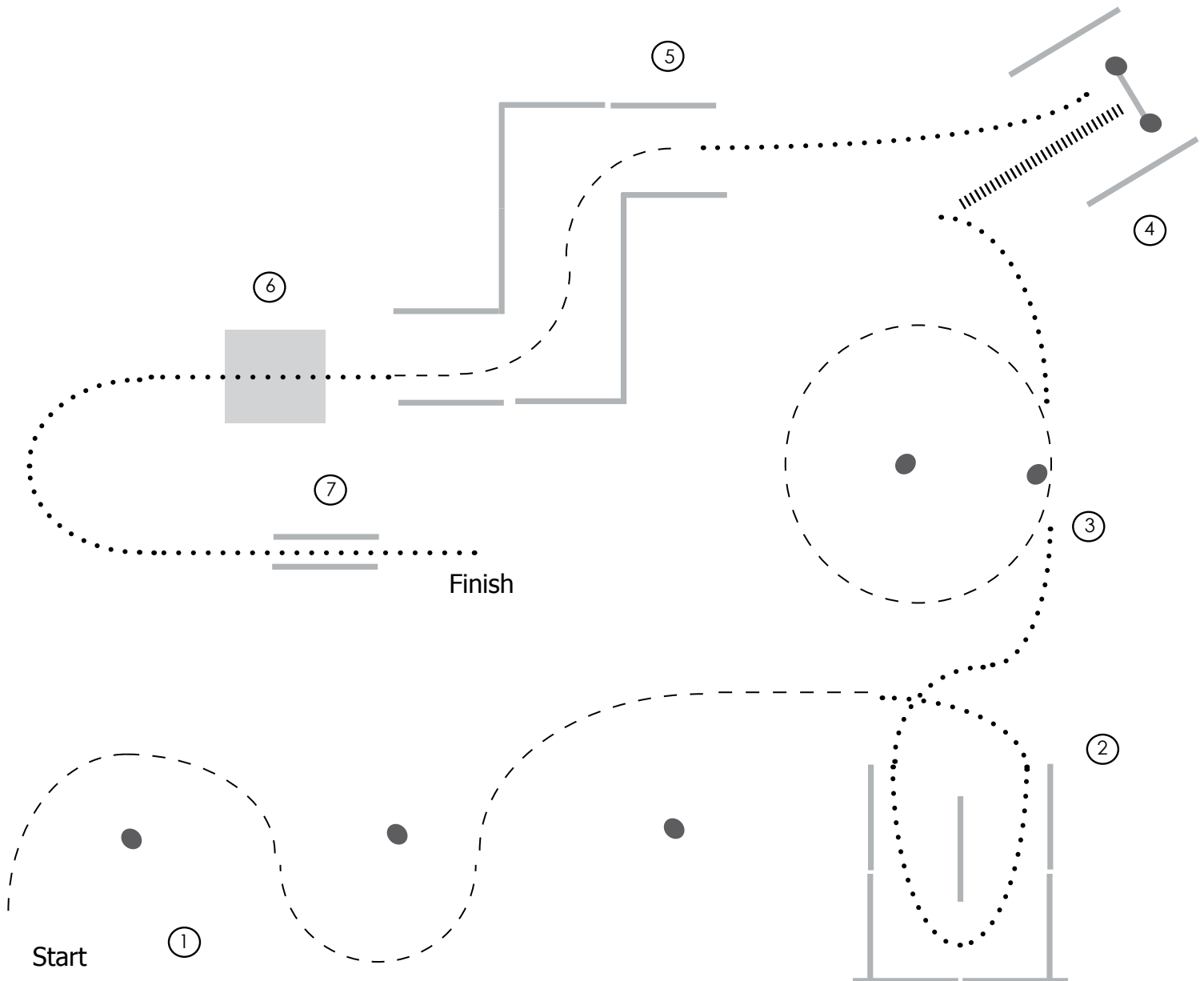

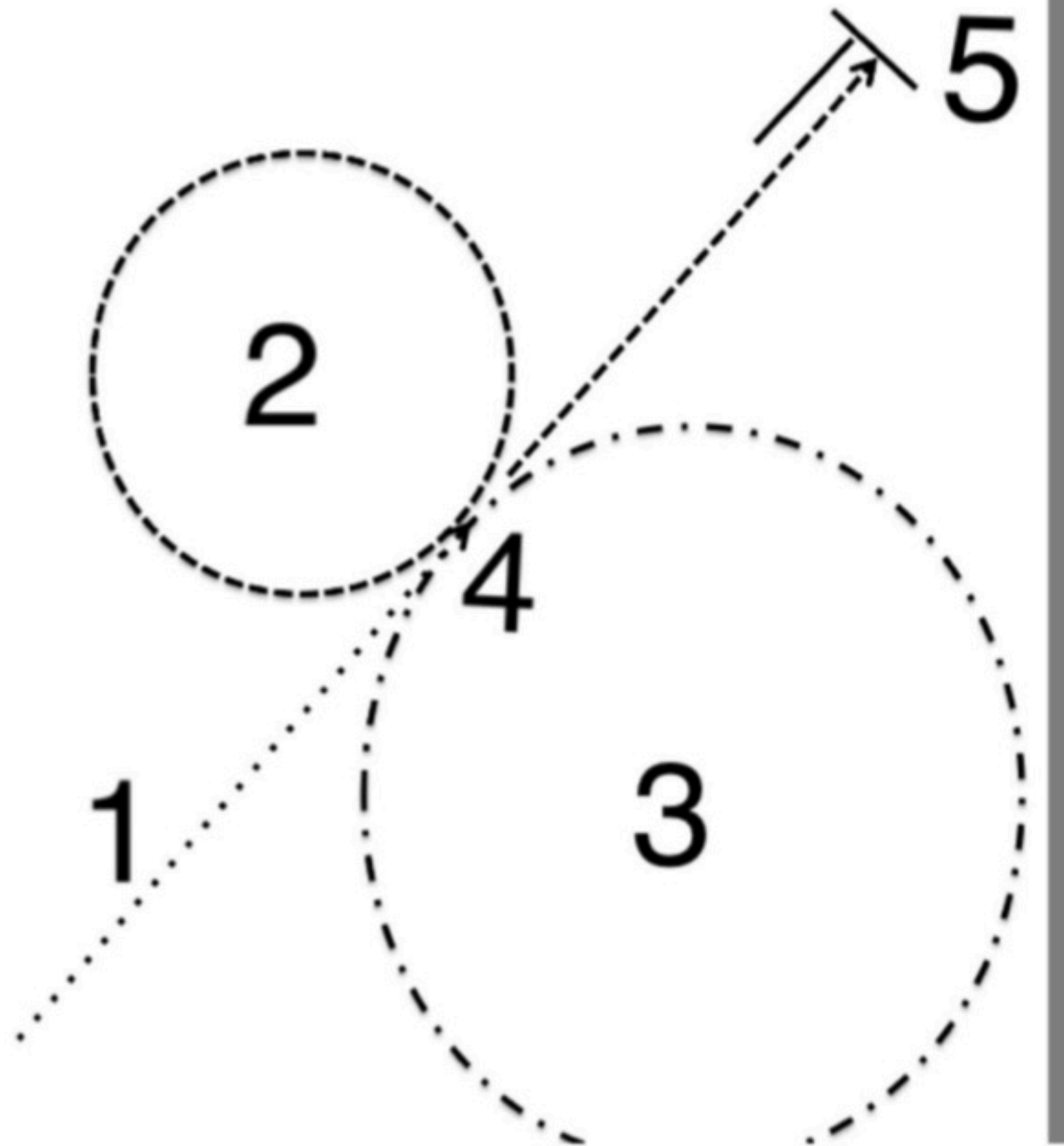

5. Stop and Back

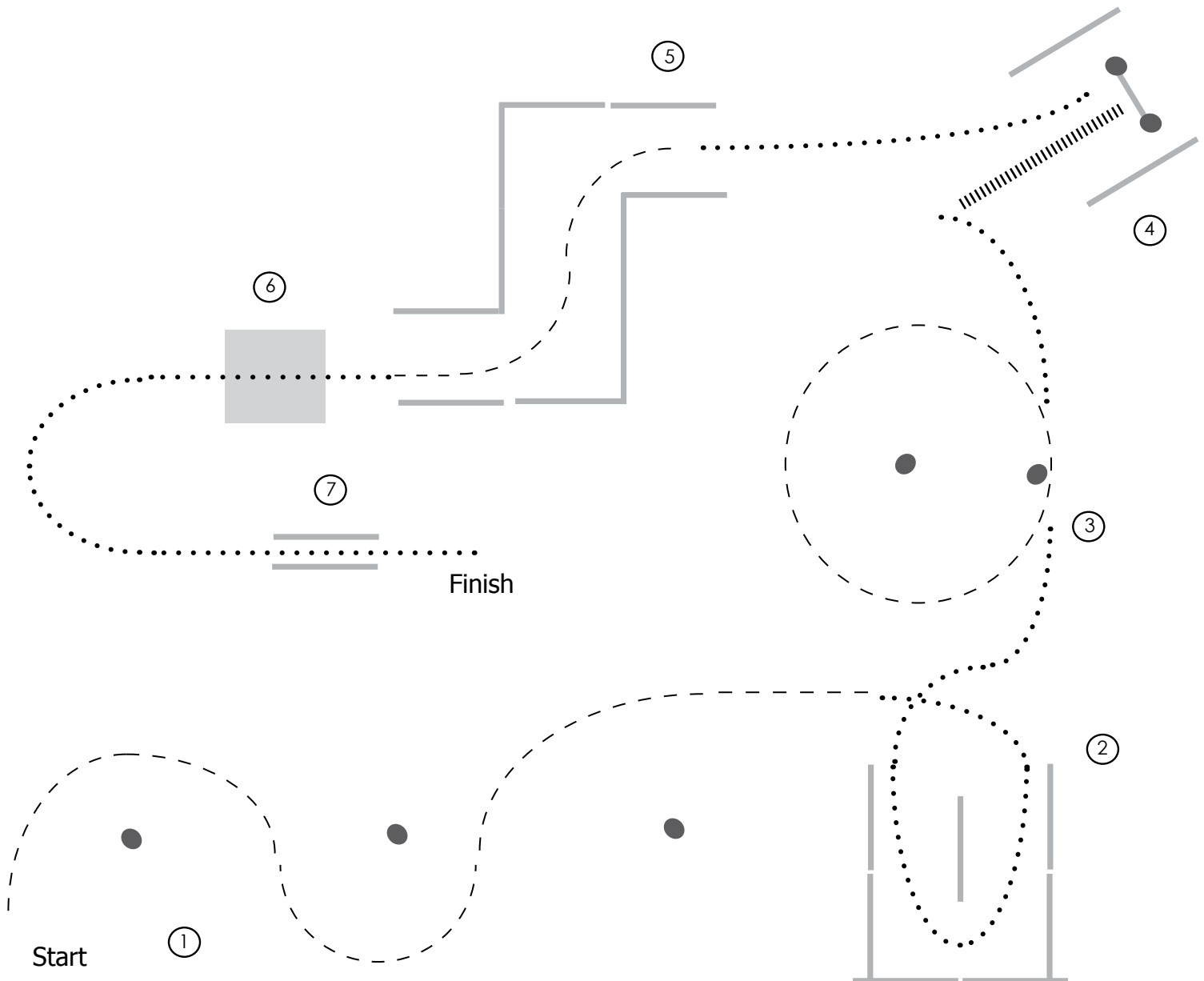
# Obstacle Driving

## Instructions

1. Trot through cones
2. Drive through "U" at the walk
3. Walk up to and pick up object, then trot around center cone, drop off object in original location
4. Walk up, turn and back to knock off pole
5. Walk forward then drive between poles at the trot
6. Stop or break to walk, walk over plywood on the ground
7. Walk up to and then position wheel and keep left wheel between poles while walking forward

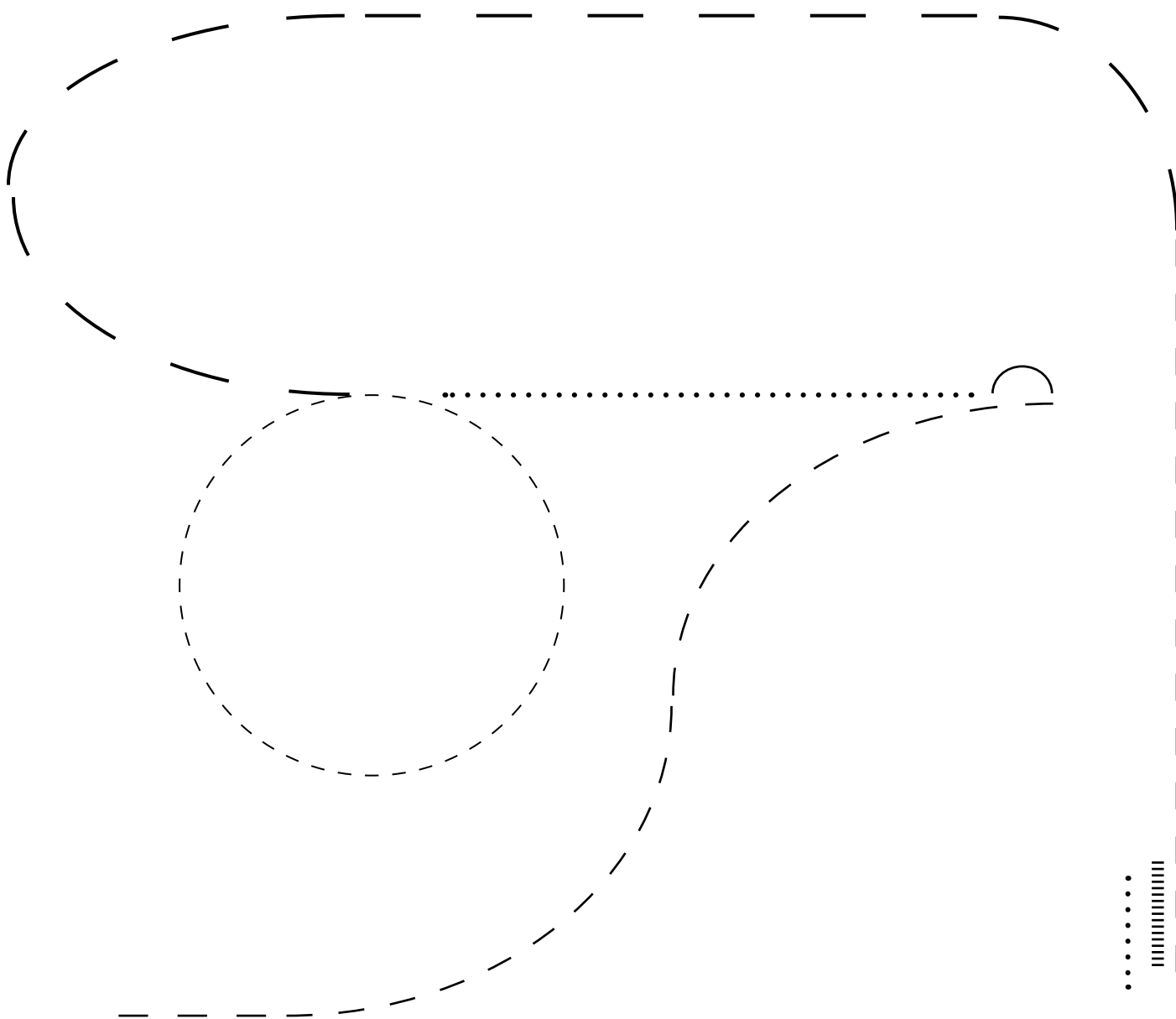
