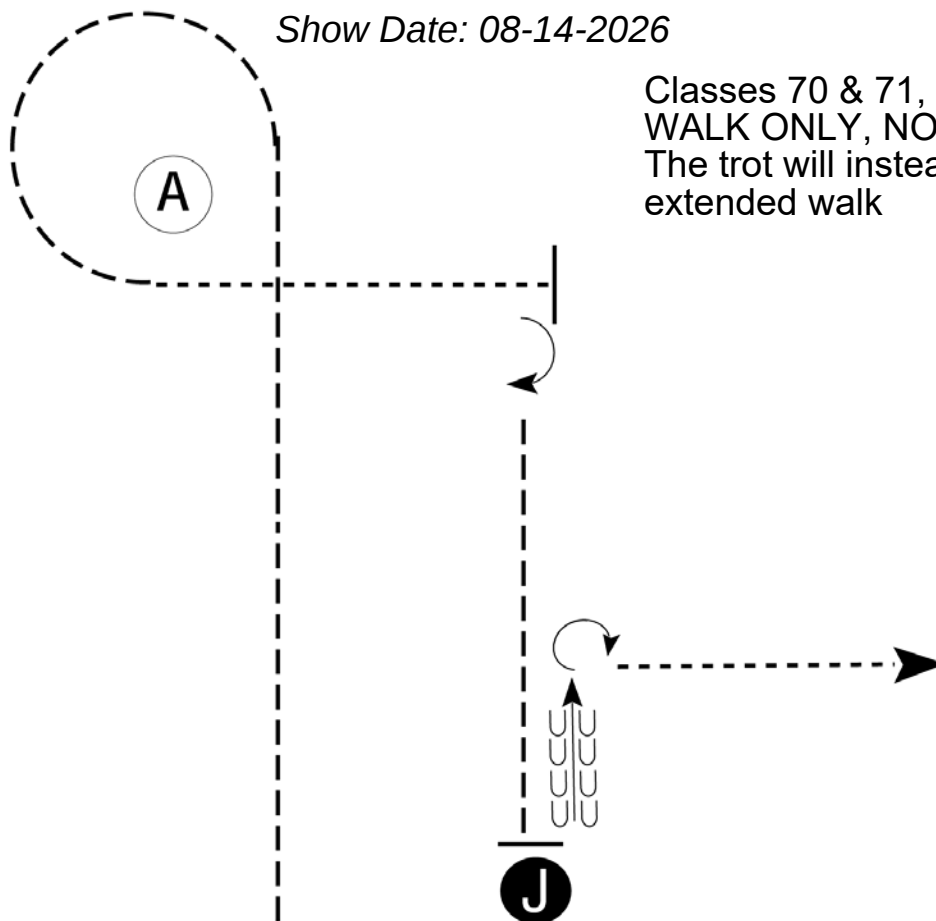
1. Walk over bridge.
2. Normal trot, circle (either way first).
3. Halt at X and "pick an apple."
4. Pick up normal trot and continue other circle of the figure eight.
5. Walk right U-turn, stop before leaving U-turn and drop apple in bucket, continue to walk.
6. Normal trot through road signs.
7. Extend a trot along rail until passing bridge.
8. Walk into chute and back.
Pattern is complete.

Be ready even with judge.

1. Trot to and around A.
2. Walk from A until even with judge.
3. Stop and perform a 90 degree turn.
4. Trot to judge.
5. Stop and set up for inspection.
6. When dismissed, back approximately 2 horse lengths.
7. Perform a 270 degree turn.
8. Walk straight away from judge.

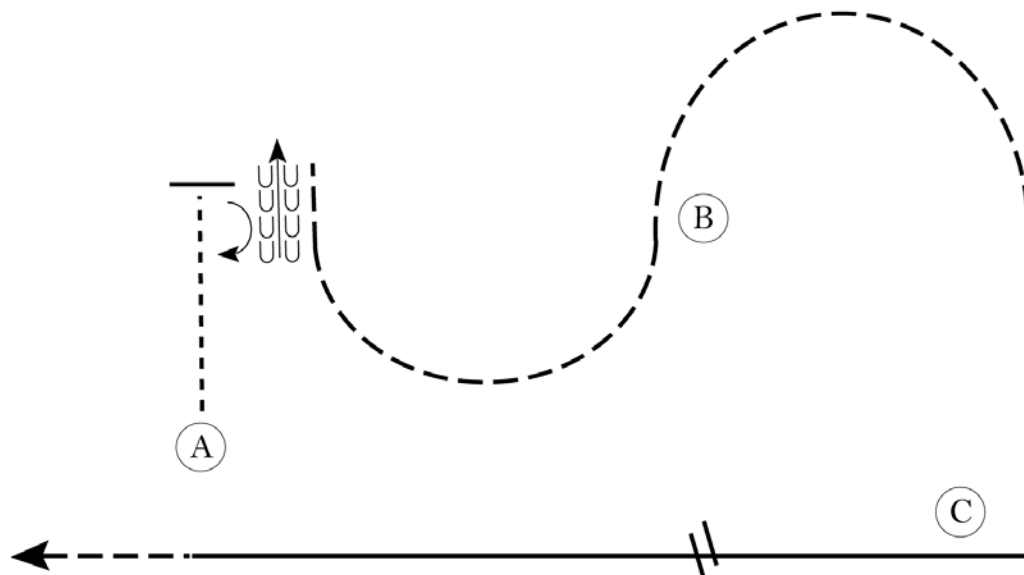

Be ready with your horse's tail to A.

1. Walk until even with B.
2. Stop and perform a 180 degree turn on the forehand right.
3. Back approximately one horse length.
4. Rising trot serpentine as shown - change diagonals at B.
5. When even with B, canter right lead around C.
6. When even with B, change leads and canter until even with A.
7. Break to a sitting trot when even with A.

Pattern is over once you have passed A at the trot.

Follow the directions of your ring steward.

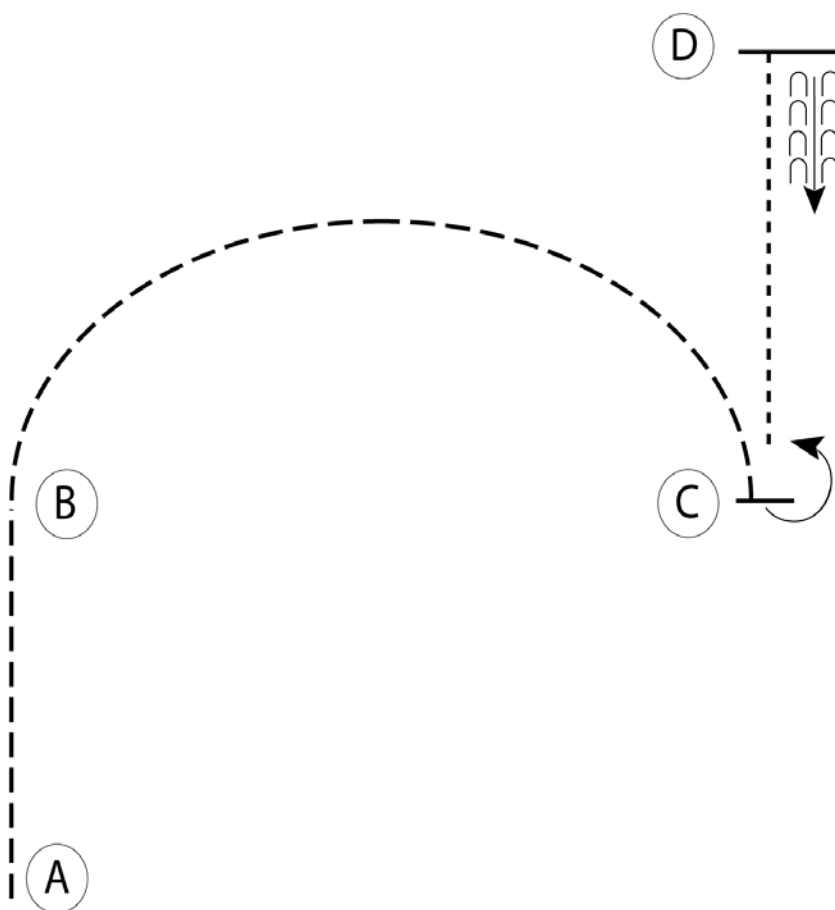

3. At C stop and perform a 180 degree turn on the forehand to the left.
4. Walk to D.
5. At D, stop and back approximately one horse length.

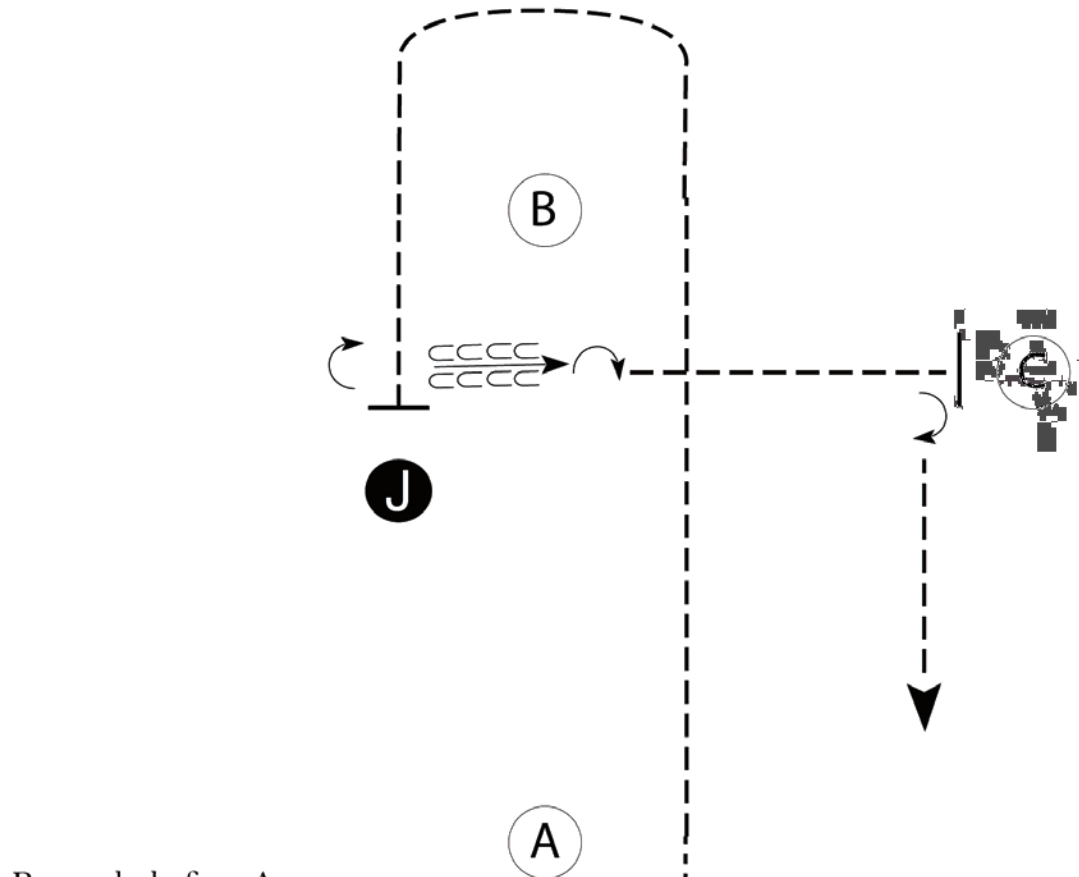

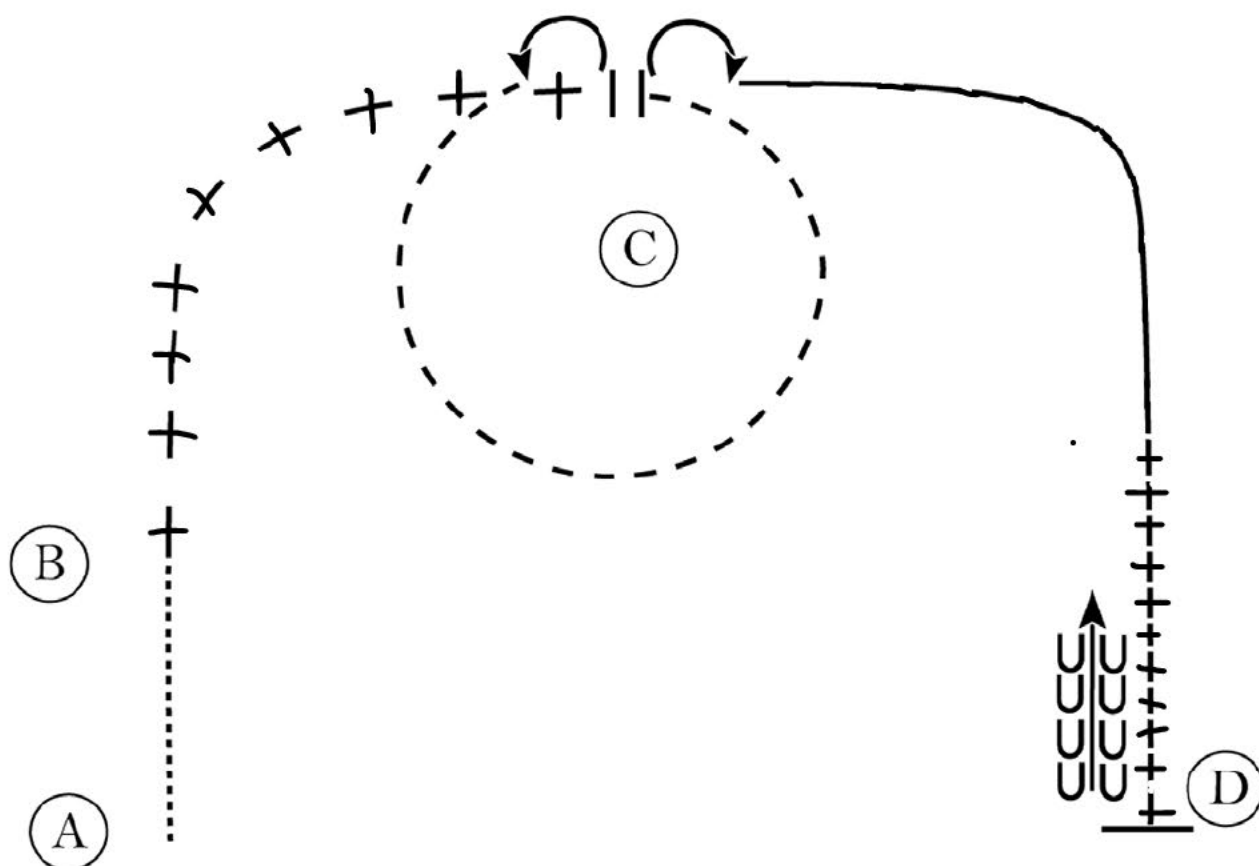

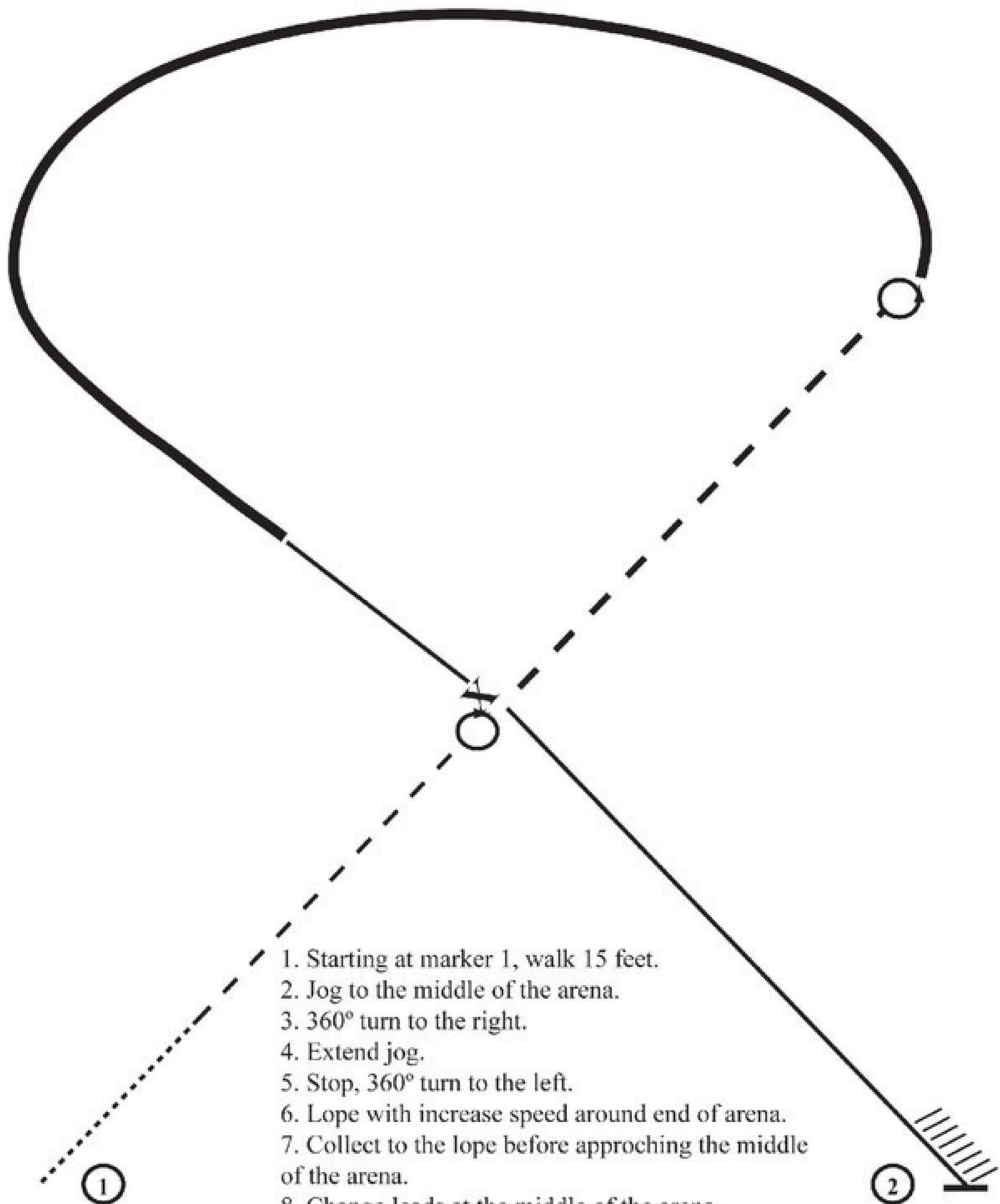

8. Stop at D and back approximately one-horse length.

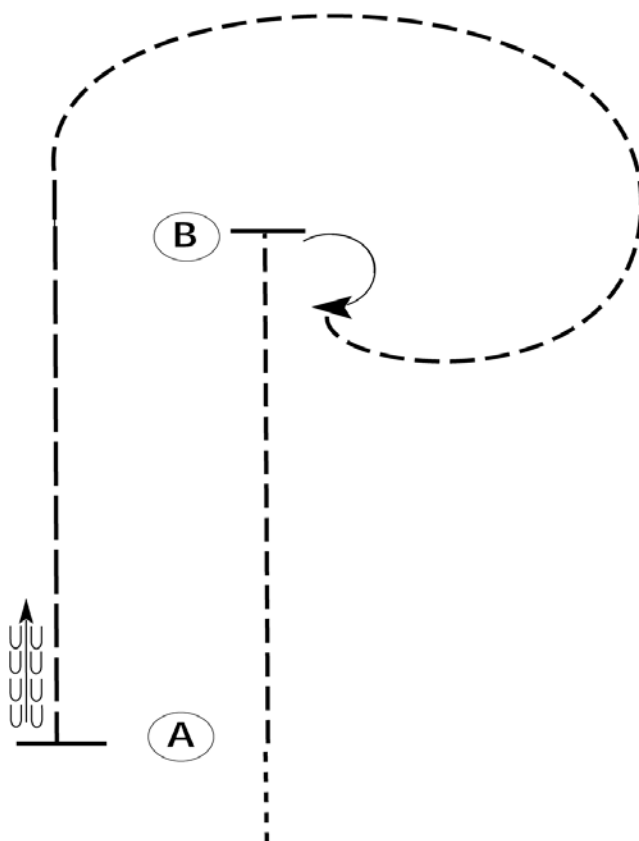


1. Starting at marker 1, walk 15 feet.
2. Jog to the middle of the arena.
3. 360° turn to the right.
4. Extend jog.
5. Stop, 360° turn to the left.
6. Lope with increase speed around end of arena.
7. Collect to the lope before approaching the middle of the arena.
8. Change leads at the middle of the arena.
9. Lope on the right lead to marker 2.
10. Stop and back 2 horse lengths. Exit at the walk or jog.

NOTE: The drawn description of this pattern is only intended for the general depiction of the pattern. Contestants should utilize the arena space to best exhibit their horses.
